

NEWSLETTER TO PARENTS

END OF SECOND TERM 2024/2025 ACADEMIC SESSION

1. We are grateful to God for His sustenance throughout the Second Term of 2024/2025 Academic Session. We also wish to thank our dear parents for cooperating with the School to achieve its desired goals.

SCHOOL FEES

2. The tuition/boarding fees and other charges are to be paid to any Zenith Bank Branch into account number 1228370177 in favour of Air Force Comprehensive School Kaduna and printout be collected as evidence of payment. No cash payment will be accepted in the School on resumption day. Students must show evidence of full payment of fees at the gate before they will be allowed into the School premises on resumption day. Military Children are to resume with POR/Part 2 Order/Letter of Introduction from NAVSEC while Teachers/staff children are to come with copy of letter of appointment. Any child that fails to present this document will be asked to pay the balance of Second Term fees and full payment of fees for Third Term 2024/2025 Academic Session. Parents are to note that the additional N1,000.00 collection for MSS/FCS/YCS was in line with parents agreement and HQ NAF endorsement as it was noted that the earlier charge by HQ NAF was grossly inadequate to cater for the needs of the worship centers. In addition, the charge of N1,000.00 for practicals by HQ NAF was observed to be inadequate. However, the schools do not have powers to increase any charge without recourse to HQ NAF's approval. To this effect, parents would

be requested to provide some items to augment the ones that would be provided by the school during such practicals pending HQ NAF's approval for such increase. Parents/guardians are kindly encouraged to note that any fee or money paid into the School Account will not be refunded. DISCIPLINE

3. During the term, it has been observed with concern that some students' behaviour was not consistent with the School Rules and Regulations. Such students were sanctioned accordingly. Parents are therefore advised to remind their wards on the need to obey the School Rules and Regulations. The School will not tolerate any act of indiscipline from the students. Note also that celebrations of birthdays are not allowed in the School. Similarly, it is against the School rules for students to keep provision and money beyond the approved limit while in school. Any act of lawlessness by students will be sanctioned accordingly. Also, the School does not condone examination malpractice, as such parents are to advise their wards to be studious and never indulge in any form of examination

malpractice. Parents are also encouraged to teach their children on how to take care of their personal belongings while in school as well as monitor their children's activities during the holidays.

MANDATORY ITEMS

4. Parents are to ensure that their wards have all the mandatory items before returning to the School. Clearance will not be given to students with incomplete mandatory items on resumption. Parents are to note that the collection of ₦5,000.00 for cleaning materials as part of mandatory items was based on their agreement as it was observed that so many parents evade bringing the items. Please, find the list of mandatory items at Annex A. It was discovered with dismay that some students willfully destroy their mattresses in order to clean their shoes. This behavior is condemnable and completely unacceptable. As such, names of affected students were compiled and letters issued to them with a view to notifying parents to resume school with new mattresses in line with the school rules. Failure to comply to this directive will lead to nonacceptance of the student into the school compound.

UNIFORMS

5. The School uniforms for the Junior and Senior students must be sewn according to the approved specifications. Uniforms/shoes must conform to the approved colour. Brown sandal is to be worn with compound and Worship wears, while canvas with white socks is to be worn during sporting activities. Furthermore, we appeal to parents to ensure that their ward(s) adhere strictly to these instructions. Uniforms not sewn in line with the approved colour, style and specifications will be confiscated and the affected student(s) will be punished accordingly. It has been observed with concern that Christian girls' students wear short skirt for worship against HQ NAF approved specifications. Consequently, parents are to ensure Christian girls' worship skirts are sewn to ankle length in line with HQ NAF specification. Furthermore, it has been observed that Muslim girls' students wear cap scarf and different colours of hijab which is against HQ NAF dress code for them. Hence, they are to desist from that and ensure they adhere

strictly to the approved design and colour of the hijab which covers up to their foreheads. This is to avoid indecent and adherence to HQ NAF approved dress code. Henceforth, any student caught with short skirt, cap scarf and different colour of uniform will be punished severely. Also, shoes not worn with appropriate dress code would be confiscated. In addition to the above, it has been observed with concern that students are fond of coming to school with mufti and indiscriminately wearing them against the school rules. Thus, parents are advised to discourage their ward from coming into the school with mufti as failure to adhere to this directive will attract confiscation and severe sanctions.

PTA MEETING/VISITING DAY

6. The Open/PTA Meeting/Visiting Day activities for Third Term 2024/2025 Academic Session is scheduled for 21 June 2025. Parents/class teachers' interaction forum will hold between 08.00am to 10.00am and it is mandatory. On the other hand, the PTA meeting will commence between 11.00am to 1.00pm while Visiting Day activities will end by 5.00pm.

HOLIDAY ACTIVITIES

7. Parents are advised to engage their ward(s) in educative programmes during the vacation, particularly in English Language and Mathematics. Such programmes are necessary to occupy and prepare them for serious academic work next term. Parents should also ensure personal security of the children by not allowing them to go to unsafe places especially during the Easter and Sallah celebrations.

PRE – RESUMPTION MEDICAL TEST

8. Parents are to carry out pregnancy test for female students in any military or government hospital. The results of the tests are to be submitted to the School Sick Bay/detailed Medical personnel at the gate for clearance on resumption day. Parents are advised to report any special medical needs of their wards as well as deposit all medications to the School Sick Bay on resumption.

NATIONAL IDENTIFICATION NUMBER REGISTRATION FOR ALL STUDENTS

9. Parents are to ensure that their wards obtain the National Identification Number (NIN) and submit photocopy of the NIN certificate/slip to the Vice

Principal Academics on resumption day. Note that student will not be accepted into the School without the NIN on resumption day. Parents are kindly requested to ensure the NIN is active by cross checking it at the NIMC office before submission. Furthermore, military and staff parents are once again reminded to resume with POR/Part 2 Order/Letter of Introduction from NAVSEC in respect of their wards and their photocopies of service ID cards (military personnel) as well as ID cards, letter of introduction from unit/school and appointment letters for staff in the NAF secondary/primary schools. Accordingly, parents are kindly requested to fill and submit the Student Data Form at Enclosure 2. In addition, parents of SS 2 are encouraged to get an MTN SIM Card for their wards and ensure it is being put to use in preparation for their external examination registration and subsequent submission in First Term 2025/2026 Academic session.

RESUMPTION FOR THIRD TERM 2024/2025 ACADEMIC SESSION

10. Resumption date for Third Term 2024/2025 Academic Session for extension classes in respect of JSS 3 and SSS 3 students is on Tuesday 22 April 2025 while other students are on Saturday, 26 April 2025 respectively. School forecast of events' is at Enclosure 3. Students are to be within the School premises not later than 5:00pm on resumption date. Any student that resume after 5pm will not be attended to. Clean up and preparation for lessons commence on Monday, 28 April 2025.
